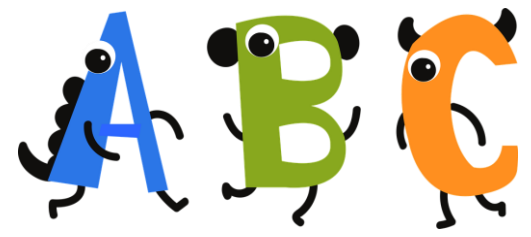

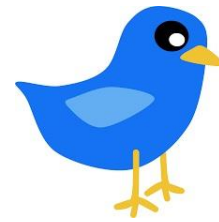
# Articulation Activities

2. Have your child tell how a bird and a bee are alike. How are they different? Listen for his/her good **L** sound.



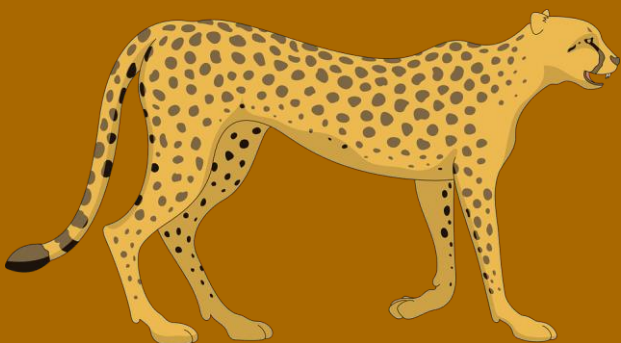
3. Have your child think of special items needed for a rainy day. Listen for his/her good **R** sound.



4. Have your child say as many words containing the **S** sound as he/she can in 1 minute.

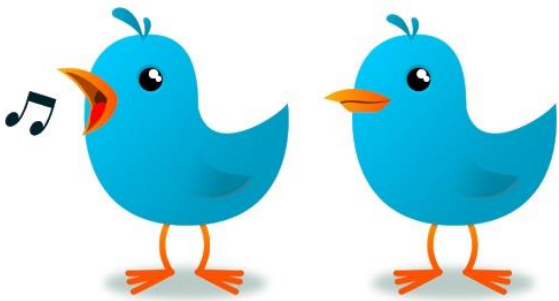


## This Week's Tongue Twister
